### Tell Café Drink of the Month: September

Also known as the "harvest month," September ushers in many changes. It marks the end of Summer, the beginning of a new school year, and the emergence of Autumn. During this month, apple harvesting reaches it's peak. To honor this occasion, the Café's special this month is refreshing Apple Cider. This seasonal favorite is an unfiltered, unsweetened beverage made from a mixture of several different types of apples. Although apple trees are known to exist along the Nile River as early as 1300 BC, the first historical record of an "apple cider-like drink" is from 55 BC when the Romans arrived in England. By the beginning of the 9th Century, cider drinking was well established throughout Europe. This popularity traversed the Atlantic to North America when Early English settlers cultivated cider apples with seeds from England. Due to the efforts of the legendary Johnny Appleseed, cider consumption grew during the 18th Century. It's popularity declined with the German introduction of beer production, but grew again in the 20th Century after the introduction of pasteurization.
