Keeping the Waterways in Manheim Township Clean Helps the Chesapeake Bay

Spring is underway and summer is soon to begin. Here is your annual reminder of things to keep in mind that will help to keep the waterways in Manheim Township clean.

- Don't dispose of yard waste including leaves in stormwater runoff facilities (ie. inlets, swales, streams and stormwater basins). We encourage you to dispose of your yard waste at the Township's Compost Park, located at 2775 Oregon Pike.
- Follow the label directions when applying fertilizers and pesticides. Rain washes fertilizer and pesticides into stormwater drainage facilities and directly into our streams. Fertilizer overuse causes algae to grow, which uses up oxygen that fish need to survive. Pesticides can also damage the eco-system if applied improperly. Consider using low phosphorus or zero phosphorus fertilizers.
- Maintain the height of your grass at three inches. The roots of your lawn grow as deep as the grass grows tall, so taller grass has deeper, healthier roots. A healthy lawn tolerates hot, dry weather better. Mulch your grass. Clippings left on your lawn provide fertilizer in the form of nitrogen, potassium and phosphorus.
- Turn your mower to discharge toward your lawn instead of into the roadway. Grass clippings should not be left on the roadway. Grass clippings ending up in our streams, lakes and rivers decompose, decreasing oxygen levels and increasing the potential for algae growth. Never dispose of grass clippings in or along streams. Report any violations to the Pennsylvania Fish & Boat Commission at 717-626-0228.
- Check to see if your vehicle is dripping fluids onto your driveway and/or roadway in front of your house. Oil, grease, gasoline, antifreeze, and brake fluid can all be washed into the storm sewers and into our water. Cleanup any spills you discover.
- Do not dump any waste products into a stormwater facility. Properly dispose of household hazardous wastes at the Lancaster County Solid Waste Management Authority's Hazardous Waste Facility at 1299 Harrisburg Pike.
- Notify the Township if you see anyone dumping waste products into a stormwater facility. Call or use the Illicit Discharge Reporting button on the home page of the Township's website.
- Clean up after your pets.

'18 Spring Street Sweeping Schedule
