### **RULES OF CONDUCT**

Skaters shall skate in a reasonable, controlled manner. If you are passing more skaters than are passing you, slow down!

Skaters shall not skate in a reckless manner, weave in or out, play tag or skate in a manner that may jeopardize the safety of one's self or others.

Skaters shall report all injuries to management regardless of severity. All skaters are requested to report conditions that they believe may jeopardize their safety or the safety of others.

Skaters shall not carry children while on skates anywhere in the building.

Skaters are prohibited from taking the following items onto the skating floor: hats, headbands, bandannas, caps, purses, combs, hair brushes, sunglasses, toys, cell phones & pagers\*, food, candy, or any item that the management deems a potential hazard.

Skaters shall not sit on walls, railings, tables, or skate room counter. Skaters shall not stop or stand on the skating floor.

Skaters shall place all shoes, coats, purses, and personal belongings in a locked locker

or check area. Management is not responsible for lost or stolen articles. Skaters shall keep all food and drinks, both fountain and bottled, in the snack bar area.

Skaters and guests shall not carry food or drinks into this facility. Alcoholic beverages, illegal substances or anyone under their influence will not be

permitted on the premises.

Skates that are designed for a toe stop or heel brake must be so equipped. If not, they must be repaired immediately or may not be used. Rental skates are available at a cost.

Wheels and skates must be clean and suitable for the skating surface with no extruding hardware. The following acts are prohibited in this facility: gum chewing, smoking, profanity, fighting, pushing, shoving, and high kicking.

\*-Pagers and cell phones may be permitted for emergency personnel only.

Please understand that these rules have been established and will be enforced for the safety of all skaters.

Skate at your own risk.

## **DRESS AND CONDUCT CODE**

Skaters shall conduct themselves as ladies and gentlemen.

No in and out privileges, loitering or littering around the building... "when you leave - you leave"

All skaters shall be neatly groomed and clean.

Proper attire shall be worn at all times.

All skaters renting skates will be required to wear socks.

Skaters shall tuck shoelaces inside the rental skates and return them to the rental area when the session is over.

Parent/Guardian spectators only.

Management reserves the right to refuse admission or eject without refund anyone not meeting the standards set forth.

Inappropriate attire includes the following: Loose chains/necklaces, tube tops, belly shirts, spaghetti straps, chest shirts, hats, caps, headbands, bandannas.

Any additions or changes are at the discretion of the management.

## Rules of Conduct

- No in and out privileges, loitering or littering around the building when you leave you leave" • All skaters renting skates will be required to wear socks. If you feel t skates are defective or improperly adjusted, please return them to the skate counter your rental

immediately! • Skaters need to tuck shoelaces inside the rental skate and return them to the rental area when the session is over

- We do not charge for GUARDIANS/PARENTS-GRANDPARENTS who are not skating. However, we do have to charge admission for ALL children, even toddlers, that are coming into the building regardless of whether they are skating or not. It is only for GUARDIANS/PARENTS/GRANDPARENTS that the admission fee is

waived.

- Management reserves the right to refuse admission or eject without refund anyone not meeting the standards set forth in the rules.

Inappropriate attire includes the following: loose chains/necklaces, tube tops, belly

shirts, spaghetti straps, chest shirts, bandannas, saggy pants, wearing hoods • Absolutely NO outside food and drink (including bottled water) will be permitted to pass the front counter. The only exception to this policy is with one of our

RESERVED Birthday Party Packages, we only allow cake or cupcakes.

. NO Black Stops / Toc Plugs Are Permitted

- ALL Roller Blades MUST HAVE Rink-Safe Hardware. No Exposed Hardware

Can Be Permitted.

. Guests shall not carry any person while on skates anywhere in the building

. Guests shall place all shoes, coats, purses and belongings in a locked locker Management is not responsible for lost or stolen articles. • Guests shall not take purses, combs, hair brushes, sunglasses, toys, food, candy, cell

phones, electronics or any similar items onto the skating floor. Smaller items may

need to be secured in pockets

. Guests shall not ENTER and EXIT the building while wearing skates. . Guests shall keep all food and drinks in the snack bar area:

- Alcoholic beverages, illegal substances or anyone under the influence will not be permitted, and the authorities will be notified. • Smoking is not permitted in the building at any time. This is a smoke free environment. Smoking must be done outside. • Gum chewing is not permitted at any time inside the facility.

No abusive/profane language or breach of the peace will be tolerated. There will be zero tolerance regarding profane language, the use of which will result immediate ejection from the rink by Management with no refund.

If you are pregnant or have a serious medical condition or injury that may be aggravated by this type of exercise, please do not skate.

- **DISCIPLINE:** you may receive a verbal and or written warning, you may be benched, you may be suspended, and you may be expelled. **NO REFUNDS DUE TO DISCIPLINARY ACTION TAKEN**

. All persons use this facility at their own risk and in accordance with all rules and regulations. Individuals may be barred from the rink or rink area at the discretion of the Manager for violation of said rules or for any other reason which in his/her

judgment constitutes inappropriate conduct or a hazard to others or to the Management. Management reserves the right to change the rules and regulations without prior

notice to patrons .
