Exhibits were presented by Mr. Gergely. Mr. Gergely presented all of the planned improvements at the school property. Mr. Gergely presented the requested Special Exception and Variances. Mr. Gergely noted that they had met with and presented the proposed plans to fire rescue and was approved. Mr. Gergely presented the specifics for each variance being requested.

Mr. Strausser along with Ms. King and Mr. Gergely discussed the training facility building. Discussion continued on the specifics of the inside of the training facility. The discussion turned to the stadium improvements, bleachers and press box. An executive session was taken by the board.

up. Kevin Ember and Lawrence Prescott were sworn in for testimony. Mr. Prescott provided details about the layout of the property in relation to the state highways and also PPL power poles and lines that cross the property. Mr. Prescott explained that Porsche as a company is requiring the new building and design for the dealership. Mr. Prescott presented the plan for redeveloping the lots. Mr. Prescott noted the variance request related to visual breaks.

Mr. Ember presented the specifics of the civil design and the variances being requested. Discussions with the board were about dimensional variances being requested at the site. Mr. Ember presented the variances to vegetation and screening requirements and how the layout of the dealership impacts these requirements. A discussion took place about sidewalks and the requirements/locations of sidewalks. Stormwater and site elevation was discussed.

Mt. Callahan made a motion to approve all variances request by the applicant. Mr. Strausser seconded the motion. The motion was approved 4-0.
