

Q: What is the cost of the Birthday Party Package?

A: A payment of \$210 is required to finalize the party reservation. This covers the first 10 party guests. All additional guests are \$21 per skater or \$7 per non-skater. If you have more than 10 skaters, the additional amount will be paid at the box office upon arrival at the start of the Rink session. There is no fee for chaperones not participating in skating or food.

Q: What is included in the party package?

A: The \$210 includes skate rentals, admission, a slice of pizza, ice cream and pitchers of fountain drinks for 10 skaters, as well as access to the private party room. A non-skating fee is optional after the first 10 guests for \$7 and includes all the above except skate rental. Tablecloths and eating utensils are provided. Please note the rink is cashless. Only card payments will be accepted.

Q: Can I bring my own skates?

A: Guests may bring their own skates, but all skates are subject to inspection by skate staff. Skates must have rubber toe/heel stops and must be light in color, **no black or scuffing stoppers permitted**. Rink-safe hardware (excludes any models which have exposed hardware or screws). Must be brought on-site and taken off for travel. Do not wear your skates out the doors! Wheels and skates must be clean and suitable for the skating surface.

Q: How many people are allowed in my party?

A: The party room has a maximum capacity of 24 people, so the party package can only allow up to 24 people. Additional guests may come during the session, but they will need to pay daily admission at the box office and will not be permitted in the party room.

Q: Can I bring food and drinks for my party?

A: Guests are not permitted to bring food or drinks from home, except for one celebratory dessert item for the group such as cake, cupcakes, cookies, etc. Party favors (with snacks) may be provided *at the end of the session* as families exit the facility.

Q: Can I bring decorations for my party?

A: Tablecloths, plates, cups and utensils are provided and set up prior to your arrival. If you would like to bring your own, please advise when confirming your final number. No helium balloons, wall-mounted decorations, confetti, or noise-making devices allowed.

Q: Can I arrive early to set up for my party?

A: We cannot allow participants or chaperones to enter the rink prior to the skating session.
